The City of Cambridge will conduct a Public Hearing to discuss the process relating to the two (2) Maryland Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant applications that the City submitted to the State Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD). As public offices are closed to the public due to COVID, the two (2) grant applications will be available for the public to view virtually until the time of the hearing on February 16, 2021. Citizens will be furnished with information, including but not limited to:

- Amount of CDBG funds available for State Fiscal Year 2021;
- Range of activities that may be undertaken with CDBG funds; and
- Proposed projects under consideration by the City.

The Maryland CDBG Program is a federally funded program designed to assist governments with activities directed toward neighborhood and housing revitalization, economic development, and improved community facilities and services. It is administered by the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD).

The Maryland CDBG Program reflects the State's economic and community development priorities and provides public funds for activities which meet one of the following national objectives, in accordance with the federal Housing Community Development Act of 1974, as Amended, that:

1. Benefit low- and moderate-income persons and households;
2. Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; and
3. Meet other community development needs to an urgent nature, or that are an immediate threat to community health and welfare.
