SUBJECT: Main Street Support Request

Recommendation from Commissioner Foster: That Council receive a budget request from Main Street.

Discussion:

Main Street has requested to speak to the Mayor and Council regarding a request for funding. In March, Main Street approached the City Manager with a request for \$60,000 for general operating expenses. The City Manager informed Main Street that she would not recommend approving this request and that Main Street should request funding from the Mayor and Council for specific projects that align with Council Goals.

On March 15, Michael Wheatley, Treasurer of Main Street, presented a new request letter to Mayor and Council. This request was for \$36,000. \$20,000 for general operating expense, \$6,500 for Joint Marketing Program Participation with the County, and \$10,000 for an additional position.

On April 9, Main Street requested to be added to the 16th agenda to discuss a request for \$20,000 details unspecified.

Fiscal Impact: Depending on an amount, would require reducing another proposed budget item by same amount.
